# Whole House

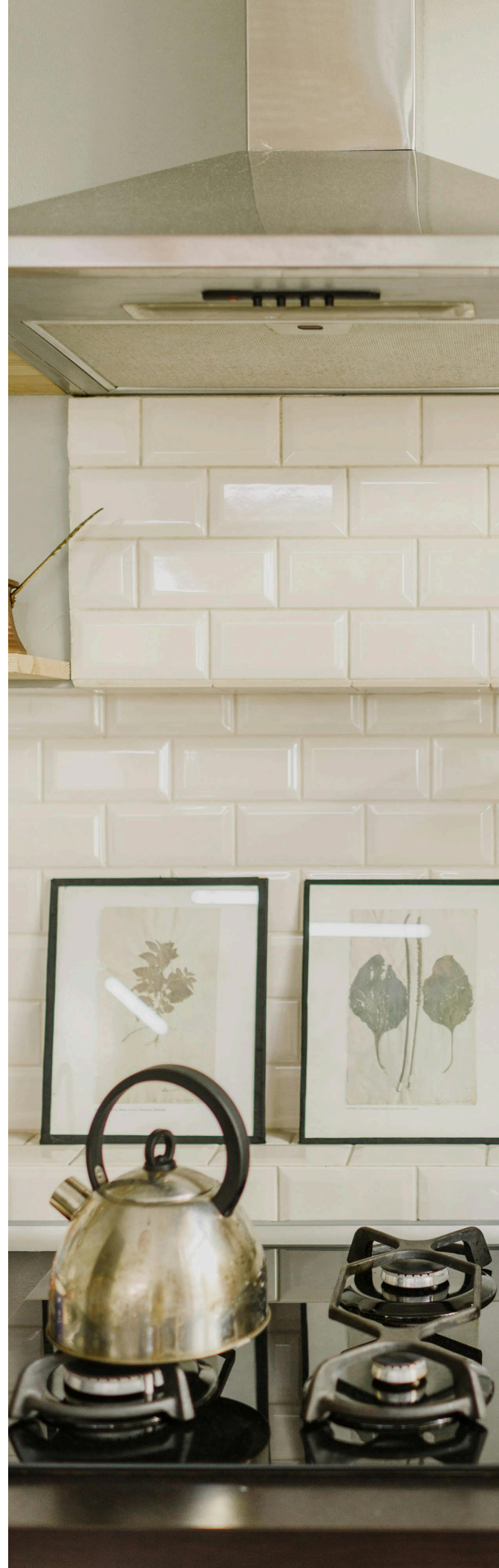
- Declutter one drawer or surface at a time
- Dust ceilings, corners, vents & baseboards
- Wash walls, doors, and light switches
- Clean windows & window tracks
- Replace HVAC / furnace filters
- Vacuum carpets & rugs (rotate rugs)
- Mop all hard floors
- Check smoke & CO detector batteries

# Kitchen

- Clean out fridge (toss expired items)
- Wipe shelves, drawers, and door seals
- Deep clean oven & stovetop
- Clean microwave inside & out
- Wipe cabinets & handles
- Clean dishwasher filter
- Organize pantry & wipe shelves
- Clean sink & disposal (lemon + ice trick)

# Living Room / Family Room

- Dust furniture, shelves & décor
- Vacuum couches & under cushions
- Wash throw blankets & pillow covers
- Clean remotes, lamps, and electronics
- Freshen entry rugs / doormats





## Bedrooms

- Rotate or flip mattresses
- Wash all bedding & mattress protectors
- Declutter nightstands & dressers
- Organize closets (donate what you didn't wear)
- Dust headboards & bed frames

## Bathrooms

- Scrub tubs, showers & grout
- Clean toilet (inside & out)
- Wipe mirrors & fixtures
- Clean vanity drawers & toss old products
- Wash bath mats & shower curtains
- Restock essentials

## Laundry Room

- Clean washer (run cleaning cycle)
- Wipe dryer drum & lint trap area
- Clean behind & under machines
